ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The Board of RTS Waste Management Limited is committed to providing waste management services in a manner that seeks to protect the natural environment from pollution to land, air and water. The RTS Board has resolved to allocate the necessary financial and manpower resources to ensure full implementation of this policy.

RTS will:

- Assess the environmental impacts of all its operations
- Comply with applicable environmental legislation and industry codes of practice
- Use registered waste disposal companies for removal of all waste streams
- Promote the use of more sustainable recycling methods and solutions through the supply chain
- Reduce the use of natural resources and energy
- Control emissions and prevent pollution and nuisance
- Manage the production, reuse, recycling and disposal of waste materials in order to minimise the amount of waste going to landfill
- Raise awareness of environmental issues in waste management and recycling through training and development of all employees, suppliers and sub-contractors
- Seek to reduce the environmental impact of projects by influencing their design and delivery
- Set objectives and targets and regularly measure and communicate performance achieved
- Communicate this policy to everyone working for or on behalf of the company

RTS intends to implement this policy through the introduction of an integrated environmental management system (EMS) that the company is working towards to meet the requirements of ISO 14001:2004. RTS is committed to continuous environmental improvement and effectiveness through its compliance with this international standard.
